

Hanging Acetate Sculpture



This sculpture is created by combining shapes and colors while using acrylic paints on acetate.

Materials:

.007 ml duralar sheet (20 x 25) or thick, strong acetate
Acrylic paint and brushes
3D-O's (foam circles with pressure-sensitive adhesive on both sides)
Colored wire
Hole punch
Scissors

Procedure:

1. Cut the acetate into 2 pieces. (they don't have to be equal dimensions)
2. Using the acrylic paint, paint a design on one side of the acetate. Use different colors, overlapping, blending and filling the acetate from edge to edge. You may leave small areas of translucent color or even areas with no color (transparent). You may wish paint the two pieces differently – different colors, different patterns, etc.
3. Let the acetate painting dry.
4. Use scissors and cut a large shape from one of the acetate paintings.
5. Cut other, different shapes to layer onto the large shape (on both sides)
6. Use the 3D-O's to attach the shapes to the base shape. If you wish, use a paper punch to add wire or other hanging pieces to the piece.
