- "A" 95 All of "B" plus: two out of "100"

"B" Full name and date on rubric
 Must be completed on two pages
 80-89 MUST be in the sketchbook AND rubric must be glued or taped in book
 Proper use of medium: wire, brush and ink/paint, pen
 Evidence of style of Calder-expressive simple brush strokes, interesting use of wire to show expression or gesture, simple lines in ink drawing to show gesture or expression
 Must include: a suspended "Calder" airplane or pull-toy
 Must include: Calder-style pop-out wire sculpture of face or circus figure
 Expressive use of fine point pen in drawing of circus figures or faces
 Expressive use of brush and ink/paint in simple, gesture animal drawing
 Mobile is drawn using Calder shapes and colors and seems suspended in space as if it were a real mobile hanging in space
 Evidence of at least 4 hours of work in drawing
 Completed on time
