

# Dry Pigment Process

## Materials needed:

130# watercolor paper or heavyweight paper  
Dry Pigment or Dry Fabric dye  
Plastic gloves to protect your hands  
Sponge, water container, water  
Plastic Spoon  
Spray water bottle

## Procedure:

1. Cover your work surface with newspaper or plastic.
2. Use the sponge and water to thoroughly wet the paper.
3. Using the handle of the spoon, lift some of the dry pigment/dry dye and scatter it onto the wet paper.
4. Continue adding more dye and different colors to the wet paper.
5. Spray lightly with water to spread the dyes a bit more.
6. Allow to dry **completely**.
7. If desired, use colored pencils, markers, paint/gel pens to enhance the paper.
