

# Plastic Wrap Process

## Materials needed:

130# watercolor paper  
Fabric Dye in plastic squeeze bottles  
Saran Wrap or other type of plastic wrap  
Plastic gloves to protect your hands  
Sponge, water container, water

## Procedure:

1. Cover your work surface with newspaper or plastic.
2. Use the sponge and water to thoroughly wet the paper.
3. Squeeze the dyes onto the wet paper and use the sponge to make sure that the surface of the paper is covered with dye. This should be very wet.
4. Immediately take the plastic wrap and cover the dyed paper, bunching and scrunching the plastic wrap, moving the dyes underneath the plastic wrap.
5. Continue adding plastic wrap to the surface of the paper until it is covered completely. You may wish to place books or another type of weight to hold the plastic wrap close to the surface of the paper while it is drying.
6. Allow to dry **completely**. Remove the plastic wrap.
7. If desired, use colored pencils, markers, paint/gel pens to enhance the paper.
