

Shaving Cream Marbling

Materials needed:

Heavyweight paper
Cheap shaving cream (Wal-Mart or Colgate works best – don't pay over a dollar for it!)
Plate/pan for shaving cream
Scraper to smooth/remove the shaving cream
Prang watercolors & brush
Water

Procedure:

1. Cover your work surface with newspaper or plastic.
2. Shake the shaving cream. Squirt the shaving cream onto the plate/pan. Smooth with a scraper to make a flat, even surface.
3. Paint lines/designs onto the surface of the shaving cream. Use multiple colors and make sure that you cover an area as large or larger than your paper.
4. Use a popsicle stick or the edge of your scraper to make lines and/or designs into the surface of the paint/shaving cream.
5. Place your paper onto the shaving cream and press to make sure that the whole paper has made contact with the shaving cream.
6. Remove the paper and use the scraper to remove the shaving cream. Allow to dry.
7. If desired, use colored pencils, markers, paint/gel pens to enhance the paper.
