

EMBOSSING POWDER PAPER

Materials

- Embossing powder (available at craft and stamping stores)
Read directions on container for safety procedures for application
- Embossing pens or stamping pad (optional)
- Rubber stamps, glue
- Newspaper or any paper larger than paper being worked on
- Heat gun
- Paper



Directions

1. Spread newspaper or larger paper under paper to be worked on.
2. Spread glue on surface, draw designs with an embossing pen or stamp designs using embossing stamp pads.
3. Immediately sprinkle the embossing powder over the surface.
4. Lift paper and let all extra embossing powder fall onto the scrap paper.
5. Brush or blow off all the extra powder you do not wish to have embossed.
6. Apply heat with a heat gun until the powder turns glossy.
7. You may place the paper in an oven set at 250 degrees or for smaller pieces, on a warm (low heat) surface such as a griddle or coffee warmer.
Do not leave your paper unattended or use heat that is too high.
