

# Bubble Paper Process

## Materials needed:

Heavyweight paper  
Bubbles (buy at any variety store)  
Tempera Paint  
Containers (cups or shallow pans)  
Drinking straw

## Procedure:

1. Cover your work surface with newspaper or plastic.
2. Pour the bubble liquid into a cup or shallow pan. Add tempera paint to the bubble mix to color it. Stir with a spoon or popsicle stick until the paint is thoroughly mixed with the bubble liquid.
3. Use the straw to blow into the bubble mix and make lots of bubbles!
4. Lay the paper over the bubbles and allow the bubbles to touch the paper.
5. Continue blowing bubbles and placing the paper onto the bubbles until the entire paper is covered with bubbles!
6. Allow to dry
7. If desired, use colored pencils, markers, paint/gel pens to enhance the paper.

## Alternative method:

1. Add tempera paint to the bubble mix bottle. Shake well.
  2. Use the wand that comes with the bubble mix and blow bubbles directly on the paper. Or, blow bubbles into the air and "catch" them on the paper.
- NOTE: This method is best done outdoors!
