Bubble laper frocess

Waterials needed:

Heavyweight paper
Bubbles (buy at any variety store)
Tempera Paint
Containers (cups or shallow pans)
Drinking straw

Procedure:

- 1. Cover your work surface with newspaper or plastic.
- 2. Pour the bubble liquid into a cup or shallow pan. Add tempera paint to the bubble mix to color it. Stir with a spoon or popsicle stick until the paint is thoroughly mixed with the bubble liquid.
- 3. Use the straw to blow into the bubble mix and make lots of bubbles!
- 4. Lay the paper over the bubbles and allow the bubbles to touch the paper.
- 5. Continue blowing bubbles and placing the paper onto the bubbles until the entire paper is covered with bubbles!
- 6. Allow to dry
- 7. If desired, use colored pencils, markers, paint/gel pens to enhance the paper.

Alternative method:

- 1. Add tempera paint to the bubble mix bottle. Shake well.
- 2. Use the wand that comes with the bubble mix and blow bubbles directly on the paper. Or, blow bubbles into the air and "catch" them on the paper. NOTE: This method is best done outdoors!
