

Waterials needed:

130# watercolor paper, Heavyweight paper, old posters, etc. Acrylic Paint
Ross Art Paste (paper mache paste / vinyl wallpaper paste)
Paint scraper (purchase from Sax Arts & Crafts)
Mixing container
Wide Paintbrush

Procedure:

- 1. Cover your work surface with newspaper or plastic.
- 2. Mix the paste according to the directions on the box.
- 3. In your mixing container, put in 2 parts paint to one part prepared paste. Mix thoroughly.
- 4. Using a sponge brush or wide paintbrush, pint the paint/paste onto the paper. Work quickly and cover the entire surface. You may wish to use multiple colors.
- 5. Immediately, use the paint scraper to create designs in the paste. Create patterns and designs on the entire paper. If you make a mistake, just paint over the area and re-design with the paint scraper. (If you don't have a paint scraper, make one by notching one side of a piece of heavy cardboard in a zigzag design)
- 6. Allow to dry completely.
- 7. If desired, you can put another layer of paste over the first, dried layer and create more intricate designs.
